Summer Camp is available to students 3 years old through kindergarten who are enrolled in SCA. It will run from June 12 to August 21, 2019. The Virginia Health Form should be submitted before the first day of Summer Camp.

IS YOUR CHILD READY FOR PRESCHOOL?

We find that most children at the age of three are ready for our program. However, here are a few things to keep in mind as you consider Sweethaven:

- Students must have had their third birthday before attending our 3-yearold program. We accept students as they turn 3 for the first semester. All children turning 3 after February 1, must wait until the June session to start.
- To attend our 4-year-old classes, a new student must turn 4 by the end of September.
- All students must be completely potty-trained. No pull-ups are allowed. Students must be able to attend to bathroom needs without assistance.
- Preschool schedules follow typical routines day in and day out. Your child should be used to following a routine at home and should demonstrate self-control.
- Naptime is a part of our daily schedule. Even if your child does not nap at home, he will still be expected to quietly stay on his cot during naptime.

Sweethaven reserves the right to determine whether a child is adjusting well. We will let you know if your child should wait another semester to start preschool.
